

## Payment Options

AGS students have four payment options:

1. Student makes payment (due by first session of each course)
2. Student applies for financial aid (grants or loans) – see two step process below
3. Employer voucher – payment approval vouchers are submitted to MVNU by the first class of each course
4. Employer tuition reimbursement (employer may or may not require grade verification) – tuition must be paid within four weeks of completion of course.

### FINANCIAL AID

Financing your college education can be overwhelming, but if you are proactive and explore your financial aid opportunities fully, you may be able to reduce your cost. Taking the time to apply for financial assistance from as many sources as possible is worth the effort. MVNU financial aid counselors are available to assist you with exploring your financial aid options.

**Getting started is a two step process:**

1. Fill out the MVNU application for admission online at [www.mvnu.edu/ags](http://www.mvnu.edu/ags). The financial aid process cannot begin until the admissions office has your application.
2. Complete the Free Application for Federal Student Aid online ([www.fafsa.ed.gov](http://www.fafsa.ed.gov)).

**AGS SCHOOL CODE is E00782.**

Filling out the FAFSA form is an important step in the financial aid process. This is required for any financial aid to be awarded. Accuracy is important. Incorrect applications will slow down the process.

Discover your financing opportunities through:

- **Grants** - a form of financial aid that does not have to be repaid.
- **Loans** - a form of financial aid that, along with interest charges, must be repaid.
- **Scholarships** - a form of financial aid that does not have to be repaid.
- **Employer Tuition Reimbursement** – partial or full tuition paid by your employer.
