Unless you are notified in advance of the ceremony to pick it up that day, your diploma will be mailed to you when all courses are completed for your respective degree and your bill has been cleared in the Student Accounts Office. Diplomas are mailed out of the University Registrar's Office to the address you have provided to them. If you have fulfilled the aforementioned items, you should receive your diploma by the end of January, 2010.

If you are unable to participate in the commencement ceremony, you are welcome to stop by the University Registrar's office in Founders Hall to pick up a diploma cover. The University Registrar's Office also produces official MVNU transcripts of your academic record.
