● PURPOSE

To become a great basketball player, each athlete must learn the fundamentals of the game. Our basketball camp is designed to teach our campers the offensive and defensive skills necessary to reach their full potential. We will develop the abilities of the more experienced players as well as introduce the basic techniques to beginners. It is also the desire of the coaching staff to incorporate the Christian lifestyle into their coaching and in relationships with the campers. All of this will be in an atmosphere of fun and excitement!

● PROGRAM

Our camp is tailored to help each camper at his particular skill level. After evaluation, we will divide participants up by age and skill into groups appropriate for them. Through personal instruction, team drills, films and competitive games, we aim to improve the skills of each young athlete and give him a greater appreciation for basketball.

● REGISTRATION

● MEET THE DIRECTOR



Matt Moore just completed his third year as the MVNU men's basketball coach. He previously spent four years as the top assistant coach at Grace College in Winona Lake, Indiana. During his time at MVNU, he has helped transform the Cougars into one of the most efficient teams in the Mid-Central College Conference. Last season the teams ranked 2nd in the MCC in total three pointers made (206) and second in three's made per game at just under 7 per game.

In addition to coaching at Grace, Moore was an assistant varsity coach at Logansport High School from 2003-06, where he worked under Indiana High School Hall of Fame Coach Al Rhodes, and he served as an assistant head coach for the McDonald's All-American Team in 2005. He has also taken his knowledge of the game of basketball overseas, working with players and coaches in France, Germany, and Kenya as part of missions trips. Moore brings a wealth of experience to this annual Cougar Basketball Camp.

● DAILY ACTIVITIES

Events occurring during this year's camp include daily warm-ups, fundamental station drills, coaches' clinic, films, league games, and individual contests for prizes.

● FEATURES

Each camper receives a camp T-shirt, chances to win prizes during contests, and a certificate of achievement. On the final day, an awards ceremony will be held for individual awards. Individual skills test evaluation on things like shooting, passing accuracy, free throws, dribbling and agility.
