### TEAM RESIDENTIAL CAMP

**June 24-27**

**At Mount Vernon Nazarene University**

This overnight camp at MVNU provides high school teams with a combination of collegiate training and competition. While morning sessions will focus on technical and tactical elements, afternoon and evening sessions will include competition against other high schools and a 4v4 tournament. Players check in on Tuesday and spend three nights in University housing adjacent to the soccer fields. Cost includes room, board, and a team t-shirt.

#### Features:

- 4 competitive games vs. other high schools
- 4v4 tournament with awards for champions
- Coaches provided for teams
- No need to commute
- Team-building activities

**Cost:** Due May 24  
\$200 residential, includes room and board  
\$100 commuters, includes lunch

### TEAM TRAINING CAMP

**July 14-18, 8:30 a.m. – noon**

**At Kids America in Coshocton**

This 4-day satellite camp brings the Cougar coaching staff to Coshocton and the quality training facility at Kids America. The camp incorporates technical and tactical training followed by competitive matches against other high schools. A focus on footwork and ball control includes learning 16 moves to beat an opponent. The camp is a great kick off to the upcoming season in preparation for training camp. Each player will receive a team camp t-shirt.

\$100 per camper, includes facility rental

**At your team's high school facility**

Team Training Camps have been a popular choice the past 12 years for high school coaches. These satellite camps bring the Cougar coaching staff to your high school to conduct quality collegiate coaching sessions to help prepare your team for the upcoming season. The sessions give attention to technical training but incorporate tactical teaching that many high school players often lack. The Cougar staff reinforces key concepts while high school coaches can observe and gather new coaching ideas and activities. (May not count as OHSAA contact week.)

The staff focuses on footwork and ball control which includes learning 16 moves to beat an opponent. The camp incorporates technical and tactical training as well, utilizing small-sided matches to teach the fundamentals of attacking and defending. Each player will receive a team camp t-shirt.
