

WHAT NOT TO BRING TO CAMPUS

PLEASE NOTE, THE FOLLOWING ITEMS ARE NOT ALLOWED AT MVNU.

- Hot plates, electric skillets, toasters, ovens, microwaves, gas grills, or any other cooking equipment or appliances with open coils (Microwaves are permitted in the apartment living areas, one per apartment and must be approved by Resident Director inspection.)
- Air conditioners (Students who require an air conditioner for medical reasons must have documentation from a physician submitted to Student Health Services for approval prior to installation. Please call ext. 4632 for more information. Air conditioners can only be installed in first floor windows. If assigned to a second floor, please contact the Director of Residence Life at ext. 4605.)
- Loft type furniture/beds from home (Extra-long mattresses may be requested by calling extension 4600 or 4602.)
- Carpet that requires being taped to the floor
- Furnishings that require holes drilled into the walls
- More than one upholstered chair per room (restricted to 60 inches in length)
- Fireworks of any kind
- Pornographic, indecent, offensive pictures and literature
- Harmful drugs, alcoholic beverages, and tobacco products
- Firearms of any kind (includes air rifles, pellet/paint guns, etc.)
- Gasoline, propane, or other combustible materials
- Candles or incense. (The possession of devices for burning incense and candles is prohibited. These items will be immediately confiscated.)
- Pets (Except aquatic animals—fish, small underwater turtles or frogs—contained in a clean tank no larger than 30 gallons. Seeing-eye dogs may be approved by the Vice President for Student Development with specific stipulations set forth by the University.)
- Any lethal weapons
- Forms of entertainment, media, or decorative items that contain profane, violent, or sexual content, including all R-rated videos/DVDs
- Christmas/string lights (indoor and/or outdoor) except during the Christmas season (approximately Thanksgiving break-Christmas break)
- Space heaters
- Satellite reception equipment
- Halogen lamps
- Irons without automatic shut-off systems
- Multi-plug extension cords
- Multi-plug adapters
