- Parking is available near the R.R. Hodges Chapel/Auditorium and the Jetter School of Business parking lots.

Unless you are notified in advance of the ceremony to pick it up that day, your diploma will be mailed to you when all courses are completed for your respective degree and your bill has been cleared in the Student Accounts Office. Diplomas are mailed out of the University Registrar's Office to the address you have provided to them. If you have fulfilled the aforementioned items, you should receive your diploma by the end of June 2019.

If you are unable to participate in the Commencement ceremony, you are welcome to stop by the University Registrar's office in the Academic Services Building to pick up a diploma cover.
