Adjunct Instructor – Computer Science, Mount Vernon Campus

Responsibilities for this position include:

- Teach computer science courses using an established curriculum;
- Suitably challenge, engage, serve and communicate with students to encourage their participation and learning while maintaining mutual value and respect;
- Complete grade books, final grade sheets, learning assessments and final exam assessments in a timely manner;
- Ensure course and program learning outcomes are delivered as defined by the course syllabus.

Expectations for the successful candidate:

- Evangelical Christian confession of faith and experience (Statement of Faith required at application);
- Candidate must have obtained at least a conferred Master's Degree from an accredited U.S. college/university in computer science or a related field;
- Prior teaching experience in computer science is preferred;
- Expertise in interpersonal and oral presentation/written communication skills.
